

Surgery on Mrs. Doll

Doll Surgery:

The Doll family was on its way to Orlando for a family vacation, when their car was involved in a multicar accident. Your patient has several injuries that require surgical treatment.

Make sure you document any findings or treatments done during surgery in the notes section.

1. Prep the patient for OR. Place your patient on the stretcher (poster board). Draw on the eyes, ears, nose, mouth, and ribs with a magic marker, crayon, or colored pencil.

2. Amputate the distal end of the left leg (inferior to the knee). Color the part of the leg that was amputated in black.

3. The patient's spleen was ruptured during the accident and needs to be removed. Draw in the nine regions of the abdominal area and place an X in the left hypochondriac region.

4. The patient has a laceration cephalic and anterior to the right ear. Please suture the laceration by drawing a short line with cross marks on it. (++++++)

5. On the ventral side, clean and dress a superficial wound on the left thoracic area, lateral to the midsagittal plane, by placing the round dot bandage on it. You may want to outline around the bandage with the magic marker, just in case the bandage does not stick well.

6. The patient suffered broken ribs causing a pneumothorax on the right side. Place a straw into the 5th and 6th intercostals spaces on the lateral side. (Tape it down).

7. The patient has a bruise superior to the left orbital cavity. Color a small purple circle at this site.

8. The patient has two abrasions on the right arm. One is on the upper arm and the other is on the lower arm. Place a small rectangular bandage on the abrasion that is proximal to the shoulder and place a small round bandage on the abrasion that is distal to the shoulder. You may want to outline around the bandages with the magic marker, just in case the bandage does not stick well.

9. X-ray films revealed that Mrs. Doll has a fracture of the right patella (kneecap). A cast is applied, beginning at the distal femoral region and extending to the upper pedal region. Draw multiple lines across the area demonstrating where the cast begins and where it ends. (Hints: The femur is the large upper leg bone and the combining form "pedo" refers to the foot.)

10. The patient has a PAST medical history of appendectomy, umbilical hernia repair, hysterectomy, and cholecystectomy. Color in the abdominal regions associated with each surgery with the following colors:

Appendectomy – Green

Umbilical Hernia repair - Blue

Cholecystectomy – Yellow

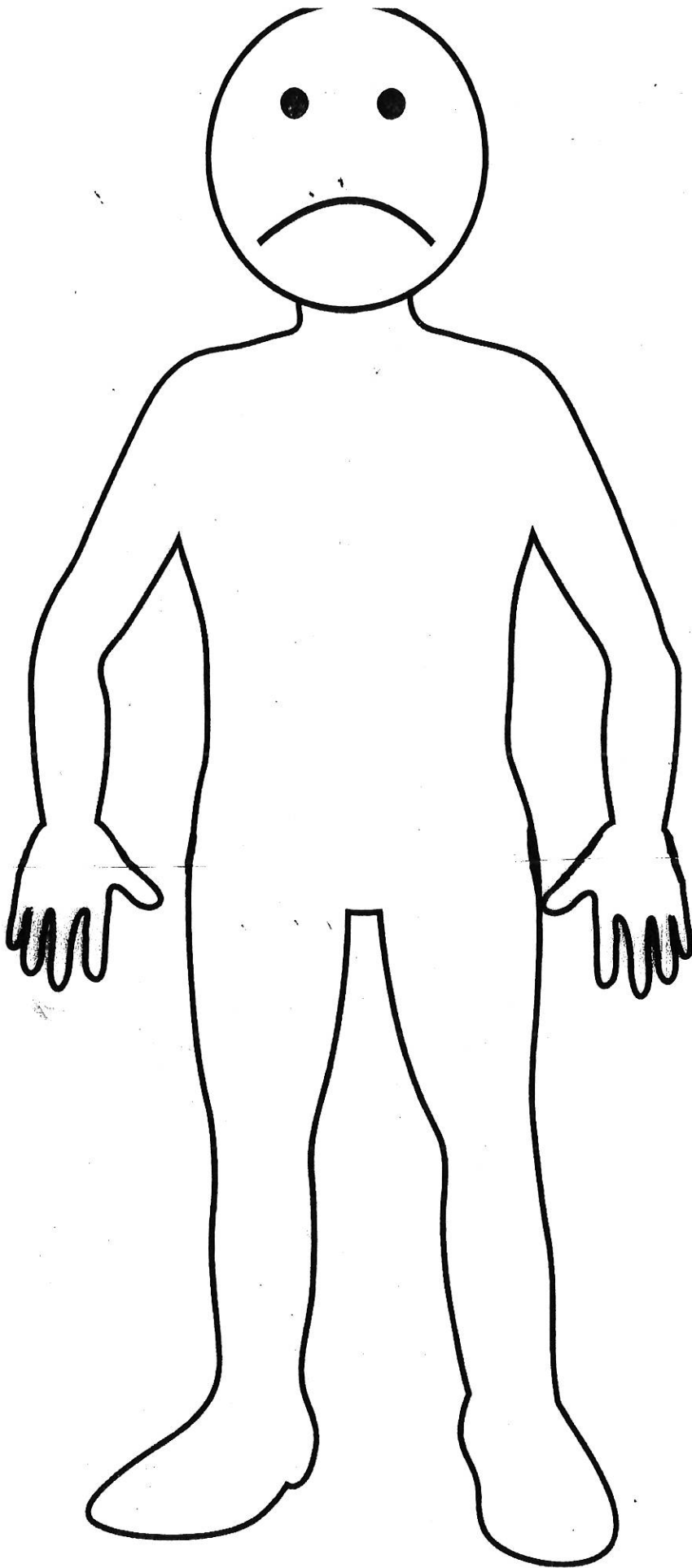
Hysterectomy – Pink or Red

11. Utilizing correct anatomical position, place an ID band with the word DOLL written on it to your patient's left arm using a rectangular sticker, and then place your patient's first and last name in the inferior right hand corner of the poster board.

12. On the dorsal side, please write your name and today's date.
