Examples: cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), vital signs, bed making, crutch walking9. Identify diseases and disorders commonly associated with therapeutic careers. Examples: chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), asthma, congestive heart failure (CHF), diabetes10. Utilize technology in a therapeutic career setting. Examples: computer, fax machine
